
OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHER

Turnouts should carry appropriate spares that may be required whilst out driving. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness, vehicle suitability, driver and groom, horse/pony, and way of going. Competitors will be required to demonstrate the obedience and flexibility of the turnout by, for example, driving between cones, and the horse's/pony's manners and ability at halt, walk, trot and rein back. This class is not intended for those who show in private driving classes.

QUALIFIERS

OSBORNE REFRIGERATORS QUALIFIERS

Classes 4, 9, 10 and 11 are qualifiers for the 2019 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships at the BDS National Championships on 21st September 2019. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the Type-Section(s) listed, disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2019 Semi-Finals. The Championship will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

VICTORIA FOOD COMPANY QUALIFIERS

Classes 4, 6 and 11 are qualifiers for the 2019 Victoria Food Company Championships. In each class the winner will qualify for the grand final to be held on 15th September 2019 at David Broome's Event Centre, Mount Ballan Manor, Crick, Chepstow, Monmouth, NP26 5XP. In the event that the winner has already qualified then the second in the class to qualify. If the second has also qualified, the rosette to be awarded to the winner. Once qualified, the horse, whip and vehicle may not be changed.

EAST RING

Commencing at 10.00am

The Cones course will be open from 10.00am to 12.30pm and 1.00pm to 3.15pm only (closed for lunch 12.30pm – 1.00pm)

for you to drive the following two Cones classes when best suits you between any other classes you may have entered in the West Ring

Please walk the course on foot before putting to and driving it

The Cones will be set to 160cm wide

You may have up to two goes at each of the Cones classes you enter. When you collect your number from the Secretary on Show day you will receive two tokens for each Cones class entered. On entering the ring to drive your Cones round please hand the relevant token to the judge before you start, to signify to him if your round is to be scored for Class 12 – Clear Round, or to also be timed for Class 13

CLASS 12 CLEAR ROUND CONES

Have up to two goes

Rosette for your first Clear Round

CLASS 13 TIMED CONES

Have up to two goes

Winner is the turnout with a clear round in a time closest to the target time. The target time will be published on the day, calculated at a steady working trot

Stopwatches and other timing devices may NOT be used by competitors and outside assistance is not permitted

One time penalty point for each commenced second above or below the target time

Your best round will be taken for the placings

RULES

- 1. All horses/ponies driven at this show must be 4 years old or over. Horses/ponies younger than 4 years old are permitted to compete in only Class 1 In Hand Driving Horse or Pony
- 2. The Judge's decision is final
- 3. Show officials and stewards must be obeyed at all times
- 4. All entrants and whips must be current members of the British Driving Society and membership numbers to be provided on your entry form
- 5. This event will be run in accordance with British Driving Society safety rules. All participants to adhere to these rules
- 6. Young Drivers The driver must be aged 10 years or over on the day of the show. A driver under the age of 18 must be accompanied in the vehicle by a competent and responsible person aged 18 years or over, a 'responsible adult'
- 7. All drivers, grooms and passengers under the age of 14 years must wear a correctly fitted hard hat when in a carriage or in attendance to turnout
- 8. Riders must wear hard hats to the approved standard
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to omit, divide or amalgamate any class, vary the order of classes and times, refuse entry, withhold a prize, cancel the show or disqualify a competitor at their discretion
- 10. In the event of the show being cancelled entry fees received to date will be returned
- 11. No entry fees will be refunded if an entrant withdraws unless supported by a Vet's or Doctor's Certificate
- 12. Please park as directed by the stewards
- 13. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times
- 14. Please do not muck out your horsebox on to the show ground. These fields are used for other public events and animal grazing
- 15. Please take all litter home with you
- 16. Where specified trophies are perpetual and must be signed for and collected from the Show Secretary and returned as agreed
- 17. No liability whatsoever is accepted by the British Driving Society, the landowner or the organisers for any damage to persons or property of or associated with any participant or spectator at this event
- 18. Entries are accepted on the understanding that competitors have read and accepted these show rules

POSTPONEMENT / CANCELLATION

Only in exceptional circumstances will this show be postponed or cancelled.



South of the A303 between Gillingham and Shaftesbury
Turn off the B3081 at the Turnpike Kennels and Cattery
into Motcombe Road
The Show will be right off Motcombe Road as signposted



NB: If travelling from the A303 on the A350 towards Shaftesbury **DO NOT** take the right hand turning signposted to Motcombe

before Shaftesbury, as this is very narrow and hilly,

but rather continue into Shaftesbury and at the roundabout

(with filling station on left) take the B3081 towards Gillingham

At the Turnpike Kennels and Cattery turn right into Motcombe Road
